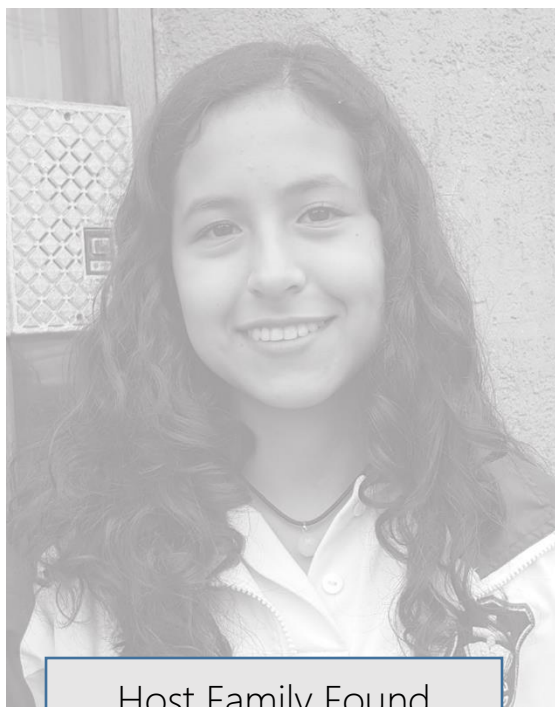




Chilean Youth Exchange Program
